2. Read pp. 931 to 935 in your textbook and answer the following questions in your notebook:
  - A. What was the ultimate result of Mao's radical communist policies?
  - B. List **Deng Xiaoping's "Four Modernizations."**
  - C. How did Deng reform China and eliminate the excesses and failed policies of the Mao years?
  - D. How did the Chinese government respond to demands for democratic reforms in the 1980s?
  - E. Contrast what the students expected to happen [as seen in the quotation on pg. 933] with what actually happened in **Tiananmen Square** in 1989.
  - F. Why did **Liu Binyan** say that the Chinese have become so difficult to rule?
