

## Creating Your Own Notebook/Binder

Your binder/notebook should have the following:

1. It should be at least 1" thick, be clean, NEW, with no doodling on the inside or outside cover.
2. Have a tab/divider for each film. After a tab, place the following in this order:
  - a. A "Character List" sheet.
  - b. Extensive notes taken while viewing a film.
  - c. Any reading given or downloaded from the Assignment Page on my web site:
    - i. Underline key information within the reading.
    - ii. Create EXTENSIVE marginal notations.
    - iii. Questions that arise in your mind while reading the material should be placed on the top or bottom margin of reading pages like this:
      1. Q→ .....
3. Have a tab at the end titled "Tests" and place all returned tests there.

At the end of each quarter, you will hand in your notebook. You will print out the grading rubric found on the main Film page, grade yourself [but DO NOT add up your grade total], and place the rubric in front of the first tab.

Each notebook check will be worth 40 points.
