### DIRECTIONS:

- Select **one** of the following western films listed below.
  - View the film, keeping the list of general themes found in most westerns in mind.
  - Research the background information on the film [the director, major stars, film reviews, any controversies associated with the film, etc.]
  - Write a 3-3 ½ page essay and include in your answer the following:
    - A brief [about 1-1 ½ page] summary of the background of the film.
    - Your personal analysis of the film based on the list of characteristics/themes of a classic western film.
    - Are there any similarities with *Tombstone*? What are the major differences?
  - **-->** Remember that you must have a **formal bibliography** of at least 3 sources at the end. Make sure that your bibliography is in formal citations format!! **<--**
